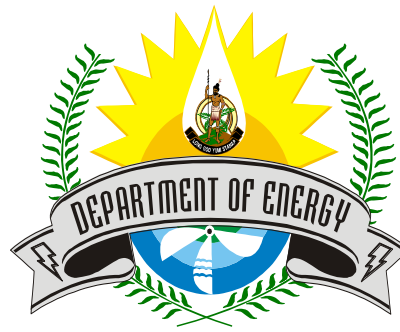

**VACANCY NOTICE**

In April, 2016, the Government approved the establishment of the National Green Energy Fund (NGEF) which will serve as a tool for the Government of Vanuatu to mobilize a pool of financial resources required to provide households, businesses and public institutions with access to electricity and meet Vanuatu's sustainable energy targets by 2030.

The Fund has been initially set up as a Unit within the Department of Energy and will be transitioned into a full fledged independent public entity. A Task Force which consists of officials from the Ministry of Climate Change, Department of Strategic Policy, Planning and Aid Coordination, Department of Finance and Treasury, Department of Energy and Department of Local Authorities, has been appointed to oversee the set up and operations of the Unit.

To assist the NGEF Task Force and the Department of Energy in executing the above stated activities, the Department wishes to recruit a qualified individual for the following position:

**Job Title:** Project Manager, National Green Energy Fund

**Term:** 1 year, may be subject to renewal based on a satisfactory performance

**Annual Salary:** VUV 2,504,880

**Location:** Port Vila

- A bachelor and higher degree in business, public finance, economic, law, or significant project/fund management or consulting work;
